Matters Arising:

Estate Names- Mr. Gilliver has sent a list of names to the SDDC and suggested that they use just the surname of the owners of the pottery works which operated in Woodville. He will carry on with this. A number of names put forward have already been used so further names have to be put forward.

Road humps –Falcon Way – Mr. Taylor said we have already done consultation letters which were delivered to the residents regarding the feasibility of road humps in this area; it was felt that we now take this matter further and consult with the Derbyshire County Council – Mr. Haynes-Environmental Services.

With regard to the comment by the County Councillor, Mrs. Farrington about the exit and entrance sign at Tesco's store in High street, this will not be able to be dealt with until Tesco's has taken this to the owners of the land for their approval. The Operations Manager they have to discuss this proposal with is Houghton Estates Ltd and any changes to the car park will also require their formal approval
